The New York Foundation for the Arts (NYFA) and Deutsche Bank are pleased to invite you to *Making It / Selections from the 2008 NYFA Mentoring Program for Immigrant Artists*, an exhibition of painting, photography, sculpture and video by participants in NYFA's Immigrant Artist Mentoring Program.

The Immigrant Artist Mentoring Program, funded by Deutsche Bank, pairs immigrant artists with NYFA Fellows who act as their mentors for a period of six months. The mentorship pairs are formed based on common language, cultural background and/or artistic discipline. Through this program, immigrant artists learn how to navigate the New York City arts scene, learn to present their work to industry professionals and acquire the skills that they need to get their work seen by a wider audience.
